All children in need from Pre-K through grade 3 will be provided impactful academic extended learning opportunities (in school, afterschool and summer).	"What does it take to create meaningful aca- demic extended learning opportunities for kids in Pre-K through 3rd grade, such that they catch struggling readers up ?"
Our Moonshot Community is united in advocat- ing for making birth to third grade an essential service and top priority supported by sustainable funding.	"What does it take for our community to em- brace birth through 3rd grade as the es- sential investment in building community prosperity, such that we move from a world of scarcity and competition to one of abun- dance?"
Our parents are trained as their child's first teach- er knowing that learning begins at birth.	"What does it take for our parents and caregivers to have awareness about developmental milestones and the skills necessary to support these such that all children are ready for kindergarten?"
